	<p style="text-align: center;">702.1. NAMING SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES</p> <p>1. Purpose The School Board believes that naming facilities or areas is a matter of great importance, one that deserves thoughtful attention. This policy establishes an equitable process by which the Board of School Directors can assume its responsibility for naming school facilities.</p> <p>2. Authority Prior to action by the Board, the nomination shall be referred to the Property and Service Committee who will make a recommendation on the nomination to the Board.  Once a facility or area has been officially named, it shall not be renamed except for compelling reasons to be determined by the Board.</p> <p>3. Guidelines Criteria that may be considered when naming school facilities are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The school district provides many opportunities for the naming of buildings, components of buildings, auditoriums, gymnasiums, playgrounds, fields, laboratories, classrooms, and equipment.</li> <li>2. A facility may be named after a geographic location and/or a section of the district it serves.</li> <li>3. A facility may be named after a person. If named after a person, that person shall have made an outstanding contribution to education, humanity or community; or have displayed outstanding leadership; or be a person of historical significance.</li> <li>4. Facilities may be named after major contributors to the district. The School Board will evaluate the financial value of naming rights based on a review of the market for naming rights. The term of the naming rights will vary but should not exceed the expected life of the facility or equipment.</li> </ol>
