	912. RELATIONS WITH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS
1. Purpose	It is the policy of the Board that strong lines of communication be maintained by the district with other districts and institutions which provide programs, training, or services not otherwise available to children residing in this district and with districts whose resident students are enrolled in programs of this district.
2. Authority	The district in which pupils are in attendance has responsibility and authority for said pupils. In order that those pupils receive maximum benefit from their program of studies, articulation between the cooperating institutions is essential.
3. Delegation of Authority	<p>In order to maintain cordial and constructive relationships with other educational institutions, the Superintendent shall:</p> <p><u>As a Receiving District</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Assure that unusual traits of individual pupils entering this district have been made known to the staff members who could be of most assistance to such pupils.2. Inform the sending district of any serious discipline problems encountered with pupils from their district. <p><u>As a Sending District</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Establish programs to ensure that pupils of this district are properly prepared to enter the schools of the receiving district.2. Keep the Board informed of any problems of an individual or group nature that may adversely affect the educational progress of the district's pupils.
